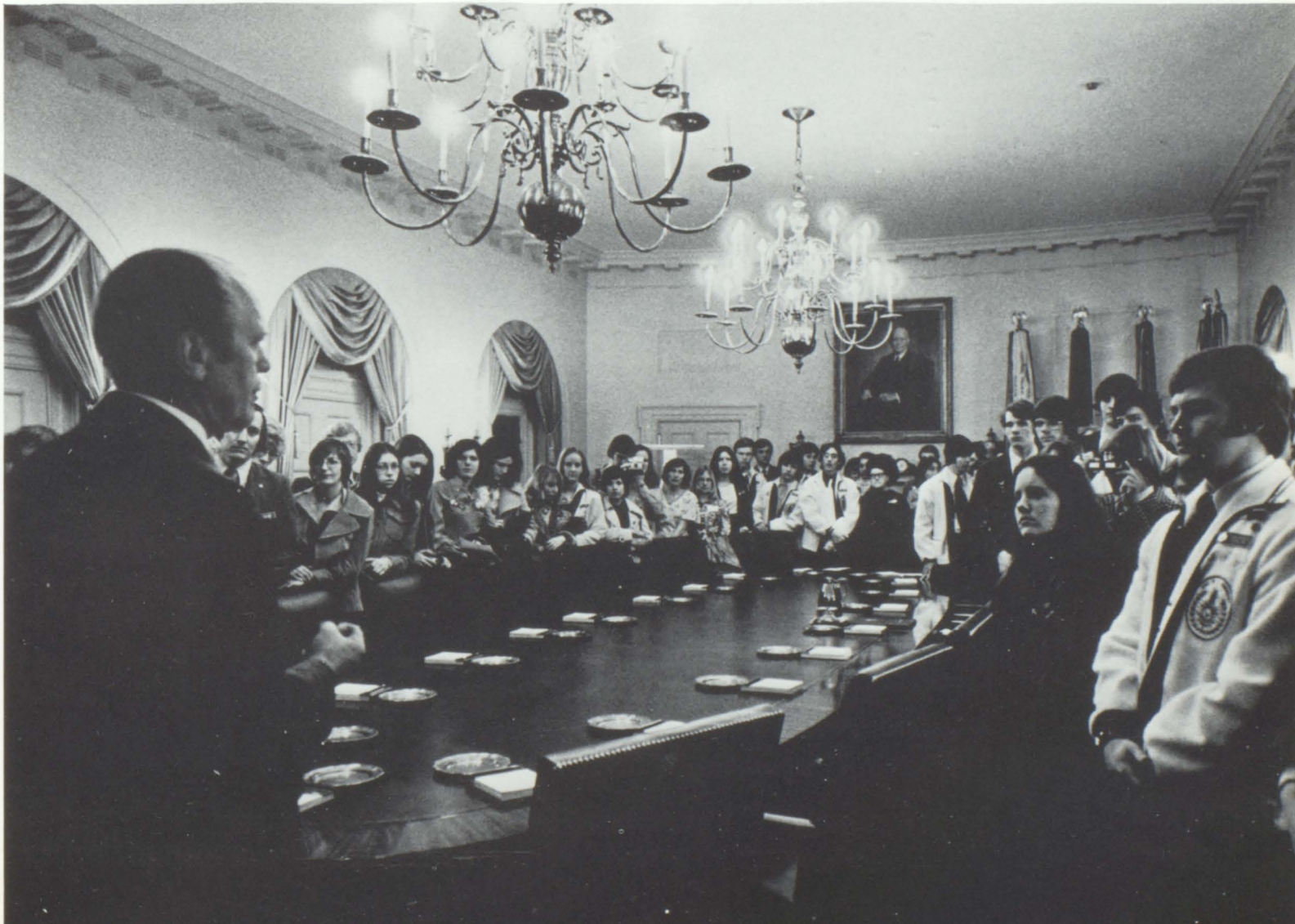
Library of Congress, where an original copy of the Gutenberg Bible is displayed.

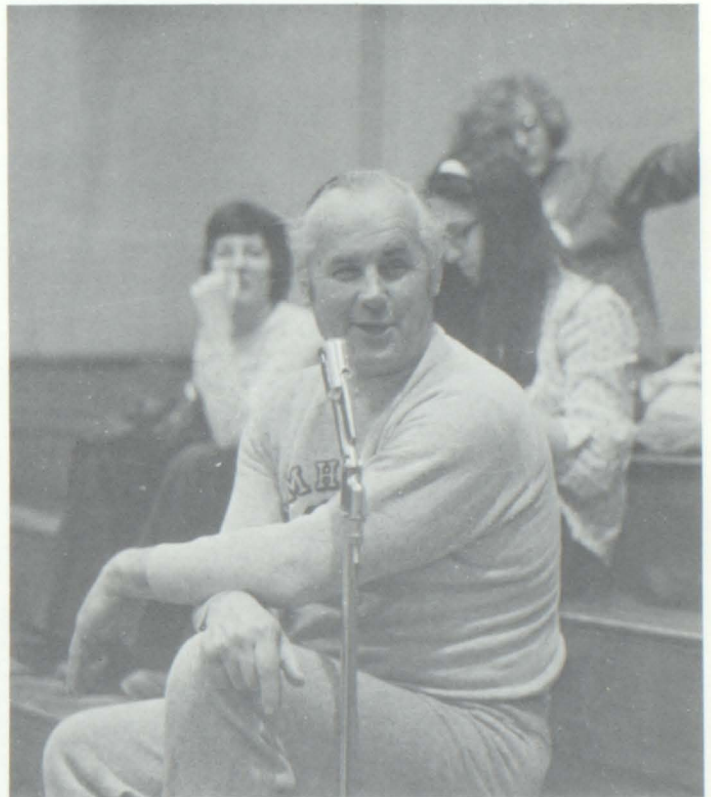
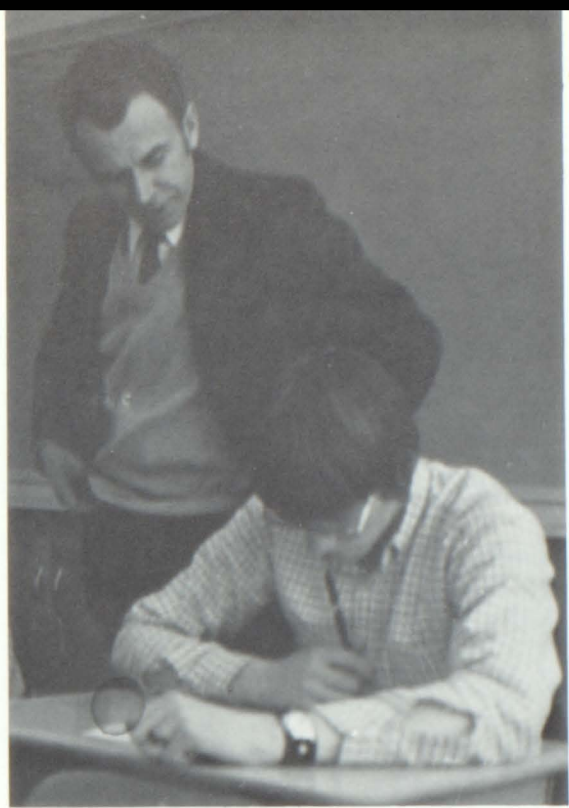
THE BRIDGE BUILDER

Why build you the bridge at the eventide?"

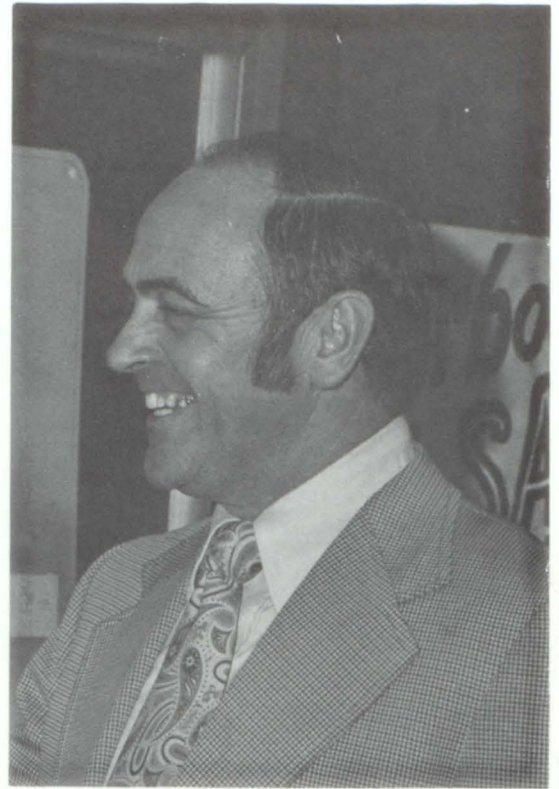
The builder lifted his old gray head.
